Surrogate Fee - Gestational Fee <i>*\$25,000-\$32,000 first-time / \$32,000-\$38,000 experienced</i>	\$25,000-\$38,000	<b>Surrogate Expense - Travel Companion for First Transfer</b> <i>*Flight and food reimbursed only.</i>	<b>\$750-\$1,500</b>
Surrogate Fee - Embryo Transfer Fee	\$700/transfer	<b>Surrogate Expense - Lost Wages</b> (appointments and travel)	<b>\$0-\$4,000</b>
